BEING AN ALLY DURING RAIDS:

- Report raids to the National Immigration Detention hotline: 385.212.4842
- Report raids to United We Dream MigraWatch: 844.363.1423
- Document raids you see happening - video is best
- Write down the names of the officers, ask where they are taking the individuals
- Ask to see the warrant. See a sample warrant: <http://nslegalaid.org/kyr/english>
- Do NOT share information about contemporaneous raids unless the info has been thoroughly vetted and verified
