The Supreme Court will hear arguments over the administration's termination of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program on November 12, 2019. At stake are protections that allow 669,000 "Dreamers" to live and work in the United States legally. The time to renew is NOW. The North Suburban Legal Aid Clinic urges those eligible to file as soon as possible in the event that the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) stops accepting renewal requests.

You will need the following:

- \$495 money order or check made payable to Department of Homeland Security *Legal services are free, filing fee to DHS cannot be waived.
- 2 passport photos
- A copy of your all of your Work Permits
- A copy of your previously filed DACA application
- A copy of your photo identification- passport, state ID, drivers license, or Consular ID (Matricula) Card
- Certified Dispositions of all criminal convictions and/or arrests
