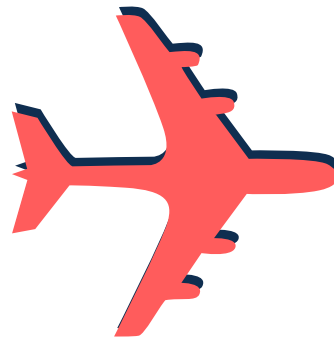


TRAVEL ALERT



Parents: Please be cautious when allowing your minor U.S. citizen children to travel overseas with a relative or friend. Even with a valid and notarized travel letter granting the minor child to travel with the adult relative or friend, Customs and Border Protection can temporarily detain your children and can order you to come pick up your children in person. This can be a risk if you are undocumented. Before traveling, please consult the Clinic to educate yourself on these risks and your rights in case this ever happens to you.

IF YOUR CHILD IS DETAINED BY CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION:

- Contact your embassy or consulate immediately.
- Call the Clinic during business hours, or if after hours call ICIRR's 24 hour hotline at 855.435.7693
- Do not go to the airport to retrieve your children by yourself.
- Find a U.S. citizen family member who can pick up your children at the airport.
