



USCIS FEE INCREASE

On October 2, 2020, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will increase fees for Naturalization, Employment Authorization, and several other applications.

Please see the chart below for specific changes:

| | Current Fee | Fee after 10/2/2020 |
|--|-------------|---------------------|
| Naturalization | \$640 | \$1,170 |
| Application for Employment Authorization (Non-DACA Applicants) | \$495 | \$580 |
| Petition to Remove Conditions on Lawful Permanent Resident | \$595 | \$760 |
| Provisional Unlawful Presence Waiver | \$630 | \$960 |
| Application for Waiver of Ground of Excludability | \$930 | \$1,010 |

USCIS will eliminate the fee waiver for certain applications, but will still be available for: U-Visa holders/applicants, T-Visa holders/applicants, TPS holders/applicants, VAWA self-petitioners, and battered spouses of certain non-immigrants
